



2025 POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS REPORTING

As set forth in Pentair's Political Contributions Policy, Pentair discloses annually (a) any Political Contributions and (b) the portion of payments that major U.S.-based trade associations and other tax-exempt organizations report to the Company as being used for political activity purposes where Pentair's payments were \$50,000 or greater.

Political Contributions

In 2025, Pentair made no Political Contributions. As defined in the Political Contributions Policy, such contributions generally include any corporate spending in the form of a gift, loan, advance or deposit of money to political candidates, political parties, organizations primarily engaged in political activities and ballot initiative organizations.

Trade Associations and Other Tax-Exempt Organizations

One U.S.-based trade associations or other tax-exempt organizations to which Pentair made a payment of \$50,000 or more in 2025 reported to Pentair that some portion of that payment was used for political activity purposes. The National Association of Manufacturers (NAM) used a portion (\$12,600) of their funds for lobbying activities. NAM is the nation's largest industrial trade association and a leading advocate for a policy agenda that promotes job creation in the manufacturing sector.

In 2025, Pentair made contributions to other trade associations or other tax-exempt organizations where either of the following was true (a) Pentair's payment was less than \$50,000 or (b) Pentair's payment was \$50,000 or greater but no portion of the payment was used for political activity purposes.
